REGISTRATION & PROCEDURES

We will be registering again this year through our online student management platform, Studio Director.

If you have a current student or your student has been a part of a summer camp, you are already in our system and should NOT create a new account. To get to your existing account or to create a new account to register: find the Studio Director link on our website: briarwood.org/balletclasses. Or click here: STUDIO DIRECTOR FOR PARENTS. Use your primary email address to sign in.

If your first choice class is full, you can still select it and your student will be put on the waitlist. You may then select another class. Be sure to go all the way through the checkout process to insure you are enrolled. The first tuition balance will be due August 15 or on your day of enrollment if after that date.

If you are not able to register online, you will find a set of forms on our website to print out and submit. We cannot take any registrations prior to June 19. Anything received prior to that date will be held until the end of the day on June 19.

EARLY REGISTRATION FOR CURRENT STUDENTS

Students must have been enrolled in 2023-24 classes or Summer 2024 classes or camp to be considered "Current."

Early online registration through Studio Director for all Current Students and their siblings will begin Wednesday, June 19, 8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.

For Enrichment & Intensive students, all classes assigned to each student have been pre-approved so you will not have to go looking for your schedule. From the Main page, click the button for "Enroll in My Pre-approved Classes." Select the Enroll box next to all of your classes then hit the Enroll button at the bottom of the screen.

<u>OPEN REGISTRATION</u> – ages 3 years (by September 1) through 12th grade Begins June 19 at 1:00 p.m. online through Studio Director.

- If you have a student who is new to Briarwood Ballet, just create an account. Then, if your student is 5th grade or older, contact us at ballet@briarwood.org for further instructions. Otherwise, you can register for the class of your choice.
- Students placed on a waiting list and not placed in a class by October 31, 2024, will be refunded any \$50 registration fee that has been paid.

Upon registration, you will receive an initial confirmation outlining enrollment in classes or placement on waitlists.

Supervised Dressing Room Service

The Supervised Dressing Room is required for children K4 through 6th grade who are unsupervised by an adult or for students in the after-school care program at Briarwood Christian School. Our dressing room supervisor will pick up children from carpool or from after-school care, check-in students who are dropped off, and assist as needed.

BALLET CLASSES

Classes begin August 26, 2024

A minimum of 8 students is required for a class to convene. A minimum of 6 students is required for a class to be retained for the entire year. Class levels and times are subject to change with notification.

Ballet classes are offered at two locations: Briarwood Presbyterian Church on Acton Road and Briarwood High School on Hwy 119. All classes are at the church location unless otherwise noted.
