DRESS CODE

- 1. Leotards should be plain and solid in color. No matter how cute they are, please <u>no leotards with attached skirts</u>, ruffles, imprints, embellishments, or designs.
- 2. <u>No camisole or halter leotards</u>. Because Briarwood Ballet is a church ministry, leotard styles must reflect modesty. Tank, cap sleeve, short sleeve and long sleeve leotards are all appropriate. **Leotard back should be solid fabric (rather than sheer or lace) up to the bra line.**
- 3. <u>Skirts for 3 year olds-USA/Ballet 1</u>: Skirts are NOT allowed in class for these levels. They are a distraction and are easily lost.
- 4. Skirts for USB-D/Ballet 2-4: See links in chart below to order required skirt
- 5. Pink or black leg warmers are allowed for Enrichment and Intensive Division students *only as a teacher allows* and only up through degages.
