

Restoration Academy is a K-12th school with more than 400 students. It is committed to meet students at their point of need, provide dynamic curriculum, competitive sports, and outlets for kids to grow how God desires. The prayer is for students to recognize God has called them as agents of change in their own neighborhoods (Isa. 58:12). The desire of Restoration Academy is for all students, upon graduation, to have a lasting, personal relationship with Christ. For the past 17 years, all graduating seniors have been accepted to college.



# alexa james blanket fort hope · columbiana, al

Blanket Fort Hope is a restoration home for child trafficking survivors. Through God's guidance and His church answering the call, a new restoration home will be ready to shelter young ladies in March 2025. Blanket Fort Hope is debt-free, enabling them to focus their resources on the restoration of each child. While their home will house nine girls, God has expanded their reach to allow them to place both boys and girls into their foster homes. This opportunity positions Blanket Fort Hope to share the Gospel with child survivors, as well as birth foster families.



# mike & trisha kennamer mna disaster response · rome, georgia

Mike Kennamer serves as the Mission to North America (MNA) Disaster Response Specialist for the TAG (Tennessee, Alabama, Georgia) Region and the manager of the denomination's disaster response warehouse in Rome, Georgia. In these roles he helps churches prepare for disasters and supports their work after disasters strike. He volunteered with MNA Disaster Response before joining the staff part-time in 2015. In 2022, he retired from his job as a community college dean and now devotes full-time effort to the ministry.

Deepening relationships have led to discipleship ministries through kids' summer camp, monthly Bible events, and weekly worship. The Sproulls also facilitate building relational bridges between the Native people and nearby off-reservation churches.



# adam venable church plant • huntsville, al

Adam lives in Huntsville AL where he serves as Church Planter sent by Providence Presbytery of North Alabama. Adam is organizing a new Church to live out Jesus's command in Matthew 28 "to go make disciples... baptizing them and teaching them everything I have commanded you." 
# Joel & holly wallace engaging disability with the gospel birmingham, al


