Then this Titus 2 night might be the gathering for you. This night is an opportunity to foster intergenerational relationships around a topic of discussion pertinent to your stage of life.

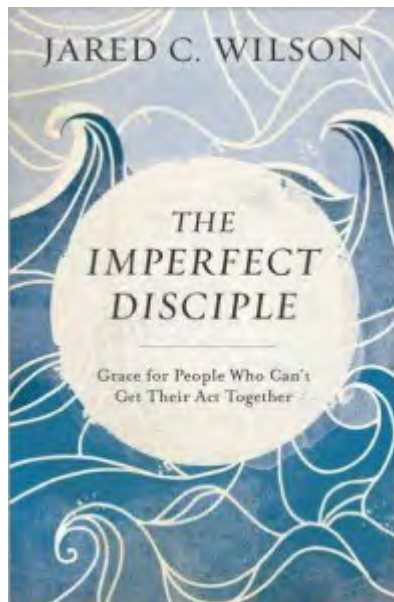
