Also, Matt holds graduate degrees from Westminster Choir College in Princeton, New Jersey, where he was an artist student of Joan Lippincott.

Recently, Matt gave his New York City debut, when he was selected to give a solo recital on WQXR - New York Times' Classical Radio Station's "Young Artist Showcase." which was met with critical acclaim.

Currently, Matt serves as Organist/Music Associate at Briarwood Presbyterian Church. Before coming to Briarwood, he was Organist/Director for St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church in Cherry Hill, New Jersey.
