- 3. The church and Christians should not be engaged politically

- Engaging in the political process as a substitute for Gospel evangelism and discipleship

A BIBLICAL PROFILE OF GOVERNMENT

- Government/State is designed, designated and appointed by God for assigned purposes
- 2. Limited in Scope, Responsibility and Authority
- 3. Civil Magistrate is to be supported by fair taxation and revenue/fees
- 4. Promote common good with benevolent policy
- 5. Protect & defend with the Sword if necessary

FIVE PRINCIPLES ON CHRISTIAN CITIZENSHIP

- Kingdom perspective-dual citizenship acknowledging the supremacy of Christ and His Kingdom
- 2. Honor and Respect to the Civil Magistrate
- 3. Pay taxes submit to governing authorities
- 4. Participate and Pray
- 5. Promote and propagate the Common Good

FIVE CRUCIAL ISSUES—2012

- 1. First Liberty—Freedom of Religion
 - Our first freedom is not the freedom of church or the freedom of worship but the freedom of religion
 - By policy there is a present initiative to redefine the freedom of religion as the freedom of worship/church

2. Sacred Foundations (Ethics & Morals)

- Ethics are prescriptive of how we ought to live
- Morals are descriptive of how we do live
- Ethics should direct morality not morality define ethics
 - a) Sanctity of Life (Abortion/Infanticide/Euthanasia)
 - b) Sanctity of Marriage/Family
 - c) Sanctity of Sexuality (Monogamous/Heterosexual/Marital)

3. Capitalism

- Dignity of work and accountability to work
- Create wealth and jobs for others

4. Political Self-Control (Law & Economics)

- Self-control within the boundaries of the Constitution and not circumvent the constitution by executive fiat
- Self control to live within our means and cease the present policy of future generational theft and slavery
