

This year's speaker is Jason Dollar, Senior Pastor of Rock Mountain Lakes Baptist Church in McCalla. Jason will be teaching excerpts from his book *Drowning Swine: How Christ Defeats Darkness, Demons, and Death*. These retreats are very strategic for our ministry because they not only deepen fellowship within

our community, but also provide a wonderful opportunity to pull away and set our focus on the Lord.

Next on the calendar is our Summer Series at the Caroline House—a weekly study in which we have a mix of teaching and small group discussion. So it is a great joy to serve a church that not only takes Christ seriously, but also wants to advance God's kingdom by strategically engaging their community with outreach programs such as Adventurers.
