The ministry includes one special out-of-town trip each year, with this year's being a Golden Isles Coastal Tour, April 8–13, going to Amelia, St. Simons and Jekyll Islands and Savannah. An annual trip to the Cove, Billy Graham's

retreat center near Asheville, NC, is a favorite and always well attended. In between these trips we visit local sites and attractions right here in Birmingham such as the Birmingham Holocaust Center.

We also have luncheons, brunches, and educational seminars throughout the year which feature a special speaker, address topics of interest to seniors, or introduce them to a particular ministry or staff member of the church. Our schedule this year has included our new music minister, Dr. John Haines; we have shown the movie, *Unbroken*; had a Brain Health breakfast seminar; and held a game day at the Caroline House. Our next luncheon will be March 19 with evangelist Scott Dawson as our speaker.
