

This summer in the Briarwood College Ministry our desire is to train students to worship God in all of life, and to impact the world for Christ. One of the primary ways we do this is by focusing our Tuesday night meetings on taking a deeper look into Briarwood's theme for the year, "Lifestyle of Evangelism and Discipleship."

We are studying our theme by teaching a series called the "Marks of a Disciple," taught by various teachers. During this time, we are reminded that before we can have a "Lifestyle of Discipleship," we must first be disciples ourselves. We are doing this by taking a deeper look into different key marks of a disciple of Christ—like sharing our faith, engaging God's Word, prayer, Christ centered living, and pursuing Godly relationships, just to name a few.

The other desire for our students this summer is to equip them with tools to impact their campus for Christ. We are studying the book of John on Sunday mornings and examining how Christ ministered to others. We also have evangelism nights, where the students go out and engaged people in the city of Birmingham with the Gospel. As the summer comes to a close in the next few weeks, we will we look at II Corinthians 5 and learn that as Christ's disciples God has chosen us to be His ambassadors to the world and to the campus. As His ambassadors, he has given us the ministry and message of reconciliation. What a great privilege to be His representatives to the World!

Please be in prayer with me that our students will be challenged to be "who" God has called them to be, and that they will go and impact their campus rather than being impacted by the campus.
