Our officers are grateful to the Lord and to the congregation for your commitment to the ministry of Briarwood Presbyterian Church by steadfastly bringing His tithes throughout this unusual season. As of the end September, our General Fund receipts total \$8.1 million compared to a budget of \$8.5 million (95%) with disbursements year to date of 92% of Budget. Global Missions receipts total \$1.8 million against a budget of \$1.7 million (106%). Praise the Lord!

May we all be Found Faithful in the area of stewardship and our personal use of the Time, Talent, and Treasure the Lord has entrusted with us.
