Dr. Sandy Willson is Pastor Emeritus at Second Presbyterian Church in Memphis, Tennessee, and has been serving most recently as interim senior pastor at Grace Presbyterian Church in Peoria, Illinois. During his twenty-two years at Second Presbyterian, the church planted five churches in Memphis, quintupled their missions giving, and established the Second Presbyterian Foundation for Christian Missions. Sandy has helped Second to engage missional issues in the city of Memphis, as well as to develop multiple epicenters for their international work. He often speaks in North American churches on the subject of the Christian mission.
