Daily Treasure: 366 Daily Readings from The Treasury of David by C.H. Spurgeon | Adult Book

Spurgeon's great commentary on the Psalms, The Treasury of David, has never lost its value. It is a true treasure, rich with Spurgeon's own comments and the collected wisdom of Puritan and other commentators. Each daily devotional includes a section of a Psalm, a suggested further reading, and a short comment for meditation, usually from Puritans authors. The Treasury will guide the reader through the whole Psalter the riches of the Word of God but will also provide him or her with bountiful material for profound spiritual reflection. Price: \$18.99
