- Ability to work effectively, cooperatively, and collegially with faculty.
- Desire to lead and mentor a small group of students, with a focus on Growth, Accountability, and Prayer (GAP).

Job Requirements

- Experience teaching high school science (preferable)
- Must have a minimum of an earned Bachelor's degree from an accredited college/university in education, science or a related field. A Master's degree in education/teaching is desired and preferred.
- Attendance at all normal teaching meetings, training and events
- Mature, living, and active faith in Jesus Christ, and membership in good standing of a local evangelical church
- A passion and ability to effectively to contribute to a positive work environment
- Demonstrated passion for and support of Christian Education

- Successfully complete a criminal background check (reviewed periodically) and MinistrySafe training (renewed every three years)

- Successfully complete a criminal background check (reviewed periodically).
