After a one-year break, we are thrilled to bring this back to our community! We are putting hundreds of intentional hours of prayer and work into our 2024 Special Needs Resource Fair, and we believe that having our fair is vital for our families in the Birmingham-Metro community.

This fair is designed to connect individuals with special needs and their families with numerous agencies and ministry resources that can provide assistance to them.

Our Special Needs Resource Fair is 100% free for people with special needs and their families. We anticipate over 100 agencies in attendance. In addition, we anticipate serving 600 families over the course of two hours. Our detailed Special Needs Resource Guide will be translated in Spanish, Japanese and Korean and an ASL interpreter will be on-site during the duration of the fair. Lastly, all of the resources will be available in print during the event and will be available digitally on our website.
