Gladys Aylward, a single female on her own, carried her passport, some money and the only belongings that she had in a small briefcase with a teapot and a saucepan tied to the handle. Many looked on her expedition to mainland China as foolhardy and dangerous. After having purchased her one—way ticket, she left the United Kingdom with determination to do what God had commanded her. She knew she was meant to go to China, even with no mission support—an unconventional theme that would continue throughout her work where she thwarted authorities, became involved in the Chinese resistance, and rescued over 100 children from the invading Japanese army. This gripping and astonishing story challenges young readers to trust God as Gladys Aylward did. Price: \$7.99
