This Year's Theme: Authentic Fellowship

We live in a world of distractions. There are often hundreds of different things competing for our attention, all day, every day – from commitments to activities, from possession to culture. Often, we give in to these distractions, resulting in us not prioritizing an important pillar in our lives – authentic fellowship.

Fellowship with God

Throughout the weekend, Ike Reeder will teach on three different aspects of this theme, starting with "True Fellowship with God". This roots our topics in Gospel Transformation from the start by focusing on what it looks like to enjoy time with God after we've entered a relationship with Him.

Fellowship with Other Believers

Then, we move to how our fellowship with God affects our view of the church. Prioritizing authentic fellowship is not merely a suggestion for ourselves; your presence in the church is a blessing to everyone there. Even when distractions hit, it's important for our relationship with God and our relationship with other believers to prioritize time with the body of Christ.

Finally, we send students out with the emphasis on a missional mindset. After we experience fellowship with God and other believers, it's natural that we want to share that gift with more people. We will talk about how to share our faith at school and at home. The weekend concludes on Sunday morning with breakout sessions on brotherly and sisterly fellowship.

Family Involvement

The students will be hosted by Briarwood families who will provide a place to sleep and breakfast in the mornings. Discipleship groups will be held at these host homes each day to exemplify intentional discipleship within the home. We hope this is an encouragement to parents and students to seek out life-on-life ministry with each other.
