Serving at Big Oak Ranch

In 2024, Briarwood sent a group of volunteers out to Big Oak Ranch as part of the IMPACT Birmingham local missions initiative. Among those who volunteered was Briarwood member Nathan Little, who was deeply moved by the experience and the mission of the ranch to provide a safe, loving, Christian home for children who have experienced trauma. As he served the ranch through landscaping, he asked himself, "How can I do more to help these kids?"

Through prayer and seeking wise counsel, it became clear that God was indeed calling Nathan to serve this ministry. In the weeks following IMPACT, Nathan reached out to Local Missions and Mobilization Pastor Max Bunn to share what God had put on his heart.

"I noticed a lot of patterns in my life of how self-centered I can be. I do a lot of things for my own benefit," Nathan admitted, "but the Lord was showing me there's so much more than me out there. This ministry is totally for others, for these kids; it's not about me."

Nathan decided to investigate opportunities to serve regularly and to pour into the boys at the ranch. Working together with Pastor Bunn and Big Oak staff, he was able to couple his love for pickleball with the ranch's need for activity and fellowship, creating a plan for a monthly pickleball program held on their campus. Now, Nathan volunteers to set up and lead disadvantaged boys in developing new skills as they enjoy fun and fellowship on the court.

The boys' excitement to play is matched by Nathan's joy in sharing his passion for the sport. Through this opportunity to be selfless, he gained a renewed motivation to steward his time and skills to enrich the lives of others. "It's totally worth it for these kids," Nathan reflects, "They impact me as much as I hope to impact them."

IMPACT Birmingham exists to introduce Briarwood members to the multitude of ministry needs right in our own backyard, to engage them in those ministries, and to build relationships with them throughout the year—just as Nathan did.

"We're not lacking in opportunities to serve. We just need to get people connected to those opportunities," says Pastor Bunn. Reaching the nations for Christ starts right here in our city, and we have many ministry partners who would love our help!

A Big Change Happened helps children who are facing a move, starting a new school, or adjusting to a new family dynamic process their feelings through the story of Wallace the whale. Wallace loves his home in the warm blue sea near the green island where he and Mama sing, eat, sleep, and play. But one day, Mama tells him about a big change—they're leaving for a long journey North! Wallace is worried and has so many questions: What will the North be like? Will he be okay? As they swim into the unknown, Mama gently reminds Wallace: Wherever you go, whatever you do, God's love follows you. Counselor Darby A. Strickland uses the story of Wallace along with Psalm 139 to help parents and caregivers walk with children through big changes and the questions that come with those changes. A special section at the end of the book helps guide children through accepting their new situation and uses biblical truths to reassure them that God's love never changes. Price: \$13.99
