## WALK THROUGH NATIVITY

Amy Duffey shares her perspective on the value of volunteering with her husband Sam and their daughter Livy, who have volunteered together for more than 10 years.

#### What's the best part about serving in the cast?

"It's just really fun to watch the reactions of the people. That's my favorite part of it. And I'm always curious how many of those people have ever heard the real story of Christmas. When I look out, I can see there's a ton of people. There's people that I know that come through, but there's also people I don't, and I'll sit there and think 'I really hope that they leave here hearing the wonderful message of the Christmas story."

"It's not just a Christmas story. It's the full story. It takes you from before Jesus was born all the way to his death and resurrection. So it's not just an activity. It's the actual story of Jesus Christ, and it's something that you just need to experience. You can experience it year after year and still pick something out that's different each time. But it's also a good reminder year after year of the entire story. And sometimes when you can see that story live and in person, it becomes more real than when reading it."

## What's it like volunteering with children?

"One thing I always request is that we do it as family because it is a tradition for us. We've been the angels for multiple years and that is my daughter's favorite. "I do hope more and more people with small families will join in on that. I know it's a sacrifice. It's during the week, and it's cold most of the time, but it's one that you won't ever forget. You will not regret it."

## Why do you volunteer?

"I don't look at it as volunteering. I look at it as a privilege to be able to be a part of that story. To me, it's just part of Christmas. This is what we do every year for Christmas because Christmas means so much to us. It is the birth of our Savior."

#### What's the atmosphere like when everyone is getting ready?

"Well, it's fun. It's community because we get there early enough to where we can catch up with people. The church is so big, so we get to see people who may not be in our Sunday School class. And then I love the people that help us get our costumes on because it's the same people every year that we see, and they're always just so kind."

#### What if it's too cold?

"We've seen it snow. We've seen it rain. We've seen it be hot. We've seen it be freezing cold and we just absolutely love it. But a lot of people are like, 'It's so cold and the lines are so long.' I know, the lines do look long, but they move really fast. It's really worth it for the story."
