Jeremiah Burroughs is widely known as belonging to the front rank of English Puritan preachers. Burroughs' writings, some published before and after his death, were numerous, but *The Rare Jewel of Christian Contentment* is one of the most valuable of them all. Its author was much concerned to promote peace among believers of various "persuasions" and peace and contentment in the hearts of individual believers during what he describes as "sad and sinking times."
